Housing Choice Voucher Waiting List Opening 8/8/2023 - 8/9/2023.

Applications for placement on the Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) waiting list program will be accepted starting Tuesday August 8, 2023 @ 9:00 AM, through Wednesday August 9, 2023 @ 4:00 PM. Or bring the application in person to 210B West 18th Street, Georgetown, Texas 78626 on August 8, 2023- August 9, 2023, from 9:00 am until 4:00 pm. Applications will be available on the website or on the outside public bulletin boards at 210 West 18th Street, Georgetown, TX 78626 or 501 E Janis Drive, Georgetown, TX 78628.

How to Apply?

GHA will accept electronic applications or in person applications at 210B West 18th Street. Applicants may check the status of their application by visiting <http://georgetownha.org/waitlists8/section8wl.pdf> 60-90 days following submission of the application.

Selection Process

All eligible applications submitted via the website and in person will be entered into an electronic lottery system and a waitlist number will be randomly assigned. After the lottery assigns the ranking, only 600 applications will be randomly selected from applications submitted. The applications will then be placed on the HCV waiting

list in sequential order based on the assigned lottery number.

If the application is not selected through the random lottery process, the applicant will need to reapply when the waiting list opens.

Director will direct the applicant to publish a notice of the public meeting and hold the public meeting. If the MS4 is located in more than one county, the applicant must publish notice in a newspaper of general circulation in the county containing the largest residential population.

All written public comments and public meeting requests must be submitted to the Office of the Chief Clerk, MC 105, TCEQ, P.O. Box 13087, Austin, Texas 78711-3087 or electronically at <https://www.tceq.texas.gov/goto/comment> within 30 days of the date of newspaper publication of this notice.

After the deadline for submitting public comments, the Executive Director will consider all timely

comments and prepare a response to all relevant material, or significant public comments. The response to comments will be mailed to everyone who submitted public comments and to those persons who are on the mailing list for this application.

MAILING LIST. If you submit public comments, a request for a public meeting, or a reconsideration of the Executive Director's decision, you will be added to the mailing list for this specific application to receive future public notices mailed by the Office of the Chief Clerk. In addition, you may request to be placed on: (1) the permanent mailing list for a specific applicant name and permit number; or (2) the mailing list for a specific county. If you wish to be placed on the permanent or the county mailing list, clearly specify which list(s) and send your request to TCEQ Office of the Chief Clerk at the address above.
