The purpose of the hearing is to consider the amendment of land use assumptions and a capital improvements plan and the imposition of an impact fee. Per state law, impact fees are required to be updated every five years to account for changing growth patterns and the subsequent water, wastewater, and reclaimed water capital improvement plans to meet growth needs. Impact fees help Austin Water keep water and wastewater service rates lower for ratepayers by ensuring that growth pays for itself.

Any member of the public has the right to appear at the hearing and present evidence for or against the update.
